Faculty attended the second workshop in the equitable mentorship series!

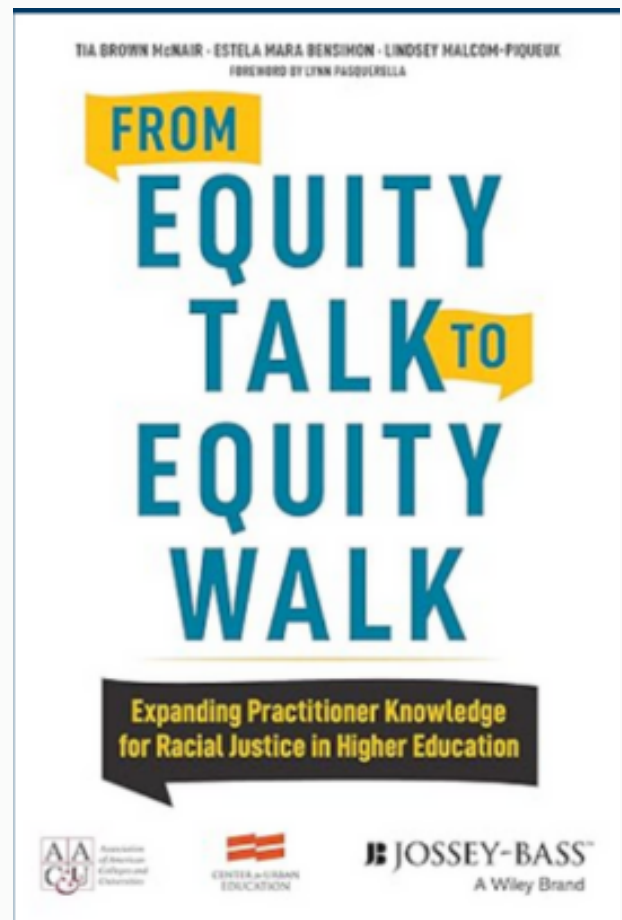
We have implemented new grad mentorship initiatives that will begin next year!
